Hardin County Honors WW II Veteran

November 11 is Veterans Day in the USA. It is a time when we remember those who have given so much to defend our freedom.

Your County Government honored a World War II Veteran, George Elmer Larkin Jr., in Fiscal Court on Tuesday, October 23 by celebrating his life and military service to our country. In addition to the historical marker placed on the H.B. Fife Courthouse lawn in 1983, on this day, we placed an interpretive marker near the East Dixie entrance of the courthouse.

Born in Colesburg, Hardin County, Sgt. Larkin participated in the famous Doolittle Raid bombing Tokyo just four months after the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor. He was later killed in action near Assam, India.

All crew members received the Distinguished Flying Cross.
