

RESOLUTION NO. 2003- 027

This Resolution of the Hardin County Fiscal Court duly made an adopted this 25th day of March, 2003.

WHEREAS, the Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation, Inc. on behalf of the property owner, Hardin County, petitioned the Hardin County Fiscal Court by letter dated March 17, 2003, for approval to relocate graves and/or cemetery located on property conveyed by Cecil N. Key and Barbara S. Key to Hardin County by deed dated September 18, 2002, and of record in Deed Book 1048, Page 73, in the office of the Hardin County Court Clerk;

WHEREAS, the publication of notice of such intended relocation of said graves and/or cemetery was made pursuant to KRS Chapter 424;

WHEREAS, a hearing was held by the Hardin County Fiscal Court on March 25, 2003, and there being no objection to the intended action;

WHEREAS, the removal and relocation of said graves or cemetery is in the best interest of Hardin County in order to fully utilize the subject property for an industrial park for the benefit of the citizens of Hardin County and to best preserve and maintain the graves and/or cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective the 25th day of March, 2003, the Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation, Inc. shall have the authority to relocate all graves and/or cemetery located on property conveyed by Cecil N. Key

and Barbara S. Key to Hardin County as herein described to a suitable site at the cost and expense of the Elizabethtown/Hardin County Industrial Foundation, Inc. as provided in KRS 381.755.
