

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-001

**CERTIFICATION OF HARDIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY, REGARDING AN ANTI-DISPLACEMENT AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN AS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 104 (d) OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974, AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, Section 104(d), requires the County to replace all occupied and vacant, occupiable low/moderate dwelling units demolished or converted to use other than as low/moderate income housing where demolition or conversion is a direct result of activities assisted with Community Development Block Grant funds; and,

WHEREAS, Hardin County has applied for and received funding for a Community Development Block Grant for the Water Expansion Project, Phase III; and,

WHEREAS, Hardin County will not demolish or replace any occupied or vacant occupiable low/moderate income dwelling units as a result of this proposed Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT CERTIFIED by Hardin County, that:

1. The proposed Community Development Block Grant Program will involve the construction of water distribution facilities only.
2. To be consistent with the goals and objectives of activities assisted under Section 104(d) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, the County will take the following steps to minimize displacement of persons from their homes as a result of this project:

**THE PROJECT IS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES ONLY. AS A RESULT, THERE WILL BE NO DISPLACEMENT OF RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL OCCUPANTS AS A DIRECT RESULT OF PROJECT ACTIVITIES.**
