FISCAL COURT OF HARDIN COUNTY

Be it resolved by the Fiscal Court of Hardin County that the Court does hereby accept the roadbed of old KY 220 and new approaches as described below into the County Road System, and have all rights, responsibility, title, and ownership for the operation and maintenance of this facility:

Old KY 220 – Beginning at the barricade located just inside the Right-of-way line of KY 1600 and extending northeasterly to the intersection of new KY 220, a distance of approximately 0.16 miles.

Any adjustments to county road approaches
