

**COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY  
HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2005-042**

The Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky, hereby adopts the following Resolution on this the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2005.

WHEREAS, KRS 189.390 (4)(C) provides that a Fiscal Court of any county may upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation and study determining that it is unsafe to park motor vehicles on or along any highway within the unincorporated area of such county may prohibit such parking; and

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Fiscal Court has received an engineering and traffic investigation and study by Danny Allen, Hardin County Road Supervisor, dated May 12, 2005, indicating that the highways in unincorporated Hardin County known as THUNDERWOOD DRIVE, LAYNEWOOD WEST COURT and LAYNEWOOD EAST COURT in Seville Chase Subdivision are unsafe to park motor vehicles on or along such streets. A photocopy of said engineering and traffic investigation is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky, as follows:


1. Pursuant to KRS 189.390 (4)(C) and the engineering and traffic investigation study filed herewith, there is hereby established a "No Parking" area on any portion of the sidewalks or hard surface pavement of THUNDERWOOD DRIVE, LAYNEWOOD WEST COURT and LAYNEWOOD EAST COURT in Seville Chase Subdivision, Hardin County, Kentucky, for the entire length of said streets.
2. The Hardin County Road Department is hereby authorized to erect sufficient signs

and notices of the established "No Parking" designation on THUNDERWOOD DRIVE, LAYNEWOOD WEST COURT and LAYNEWOOD EAST COURT in Seville Chase Subdivision. As provided in KRS 189.390 (1) any person who violates this order shall be fined not less than \$11.00 nor more than \$30.00 and neither court costs nor fees shall be taxed against any persons violating this order.

4. The effective date of this order shall be July 1, 2005. The Hardin County Judge/Executive or his Deputy shall cause to be advertised in any local newspaper at least once public notice of this order. The Clerk of this court shall cause a photocopy of this order to be forwarded to Kentucky State Police, Post No. 4, Elizabethtown, Kentucky, and the Hardin County Sheriff's Office.
