**RESOLUTION NO. 2006-102**

This Resolution duly made and adopted by Hardin County Fiscal Court on this 12 day of September, 2006.

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 2006-030 dated March 28, 2006 the Hardin County Fiscal Court terminated its agreement with the former Stephensburg Volunteer Fire Department to provide fire suppression services for the Stephensburg Fire District territory; and

**WHEREAS**, the Stephensburg Volunteer Fire & Rescue, Inc. is a recently created non-profit corporation, organized and equipped to provide fire suppression services as verified by its Fire Chief David Painter and Hardin County Emergency Management Director David Underwood.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The Hardin County Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the standard written Agreement with the Stephensburg Volunteer Fire & Rescue to provide fire suppression services for the Stephensburg Fire District effective the 13th day of September, 2006 at 0800 hours.
2. The temporary reallocation of the Stephensburg Fire District territory between White Mills Volunteer Fire Department, West 84 Fire Department and the KY 86 Volunteer Fire Department as provided in Resolution 2006-030 shall cease and revert to the standard mutual aid arrangement between such volunteer fire departments and Stephensburg Volunteer Fire & Rescue, Inc. effective this 13th day of September, 2006 at

0800 hours and shall be so recognized and implemented by Hardin County E-911 and other emergency services.

3. The Hardin County Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry is hereby authorized and directed to perform any and all acts reasonably necessary to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
