**ROAD CLOSING**  
**Federal Street (Portion)**  
**Unnamed Alley (Portion - Coopers Addition to Cecilia)**


**This Resolution duly made and adopted this 13th day of May, 2008, by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, County of Hardin, Commonwealth of Kentucky.**

**WHEREAS**, the proposed closing of the northern approximate 308 foot portion of "Federal Street" and an approximate 180 foot portion of an unnamed "Alley (15 feet)" as illustrated on the subdivision plat of Cooper Addition to Cecilia dated 1928 as recorded in the office of the Hardin County Clerk in Deed Book 84 Page 621 and by the Deeds of the Cecilia Community Ruritan Club, Inc. (Deed Book 279 Page 11, Deed Book 791 Page 654 and Deed Book 1099 Page 144), which have not been constructed, was referred to the Hardin County Planning and Development Commission for review as provided in KRS 100.324(4); and, the Hardin County Planning and Development Commission having adopted a RESOLUTION at its meeting held on the 15th day of April, 2008 finding that the closing of this right-of-way meets the Goals and Objectives of the COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT GUIDE, a photocopy of the said RESOLUTION (Number 7, Series 2008) is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to KRS Chapter 178, the Hardin County Fiscal Court held a public hearing on Tuesday, 13 May 2008, on the proposed closing of a portion of Federal Street and a portion of an Unnamed Alley to receive testimony from the public and the report of two viewers, Danny Allen and Chris Hunsinger, a photocopy of said report is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky as follows:

1. The closing of the northern approximate 308 foot portion of "Federal Street" and an approximate 180 foot portion of an unnamed "Alley (15 feet)" as illustrated on the subdivision plat of Cooper Addition to Cecilia dated 1928 as recorded in the office of the Hardin County Clerk in Deed Book 84 Page 621 and by the Deeds of the Cecilia Community Ruritan Club, Inc. (Deed Book 279 Page 11, Deed Book 791 Page 654 and Deed Book 1099 Page 144), as described in the Summary Report and Exhibits, which by reference is made a part hereof, will not cause any inconvenience, nor will it result in a hardship for any person or property, and traffic patterns and the general health, safety and welfare of the public will be improved.
2. That the platted right-of-way is hereby closed, discontinued and removed from public use as provided in KRS Chapter 178.
3. Pursuant to Jones vs. Avondale Heights Co., 47 S. W. 2d 949 (KY. 1932) and other applicable case law, the closed right-of-way shall revert to the Cecilia Community Ruritan Club, Inc. as illustrated on the record plat of RURITAN CLUB SUBDIVISION that has received conditional approval by the Planning Commission, which must be recorded in the office of the Hardin County Court Clerk, Elizabethtown, Kentucky.
