


**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2011-108**

BE IT RESOLVED, to levy the following taxes to property owners in Hardin County for the fiscal year 2011-2012:

1. A real estate tax of 10.9 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the General and Road Funds, 2.0 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Health Department Fund, 0.15 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Soil Conservation District, and 1.03 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Cooperative Extension Service..
2. A personal property tax of 12.0 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the General and Road Funds, 2.0 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Health Department Fund and 1.46 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Cooperative Extension Service.
3. A motor vehicle, watercraft, and aircraft tax of 11.5 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the General and Road Funds, 2.0 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Health Department Fund, and 1.46 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value for the Cooperative Extension Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to levy upon each acre of land within the boundaries of the county, which is subject to the fire protection tax, a tax of 2.0 cents for the Fire Protection Fund.

KRS 132.487 REQUIRES ALL APPLICABLE TAXING DISTRICTS THAT PROPOSE TO LEVY A TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLES VALUED AS OF JANUARY 1, TO SUBMIT TO THE CABINET ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE ASSESSMENT DATE, THE TAX RATE TO BE LEVIED AGAINST VALUATIONS AS OF THE ASSESSMENT DATE. ANY DISTRICT THAT FAILS TO TIMELY SUBMIT THE TAX RATE SHALL RECEIVE THE RATE IN EFFECT FOR THE PRIOR YEAR.

A number of motor vehicle tax rates have been submitted to the Department of Revenue in the past which may not have been calculated correctly. Some jurisdictions used compensating rates or calculations based upon House Bill 19.

Please note that MOTOR VEHICLE TAX RATES ARE NOT dependent upon compensating rates or the 4% limitations set forth in House Bill 44 or House Bill 19. Instead, all local taxing districts that propose to tax motor vehicles can levy a rate on motor vehicles that does "not exceed the rate that could have been levied on motor vehicles by the district on January 1, 1983 assessments of motor vehicles." Thus, a local district may levy a rate up to the maximum available 1983 tax rate for motor vehicles.
