


**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2011-144**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of the Emergency Services Committee to approve the revision of the Hardin County Emergency Medical Services fee schedule as follows:

- Oxygen fee shall be “bundled” with the base rate for Medicare patients.
- The “EMS Evaluation Without Transport” fee will apply to any individual that received an evaluation by EMS personnel but refused transport to the hospital. If the individual is at a private residence, this fee will apply if the individual refuses transport more than one time in a six-month period
- Hardin County EMS shall offer a “Financial Assistance Program” for individuals and entities that are uninsured or indigent and who do not qualify for Medicaid. This program will be developed and maintained by the Director of Hardin County EMS.
- This schedule is effective on January 1, 2012.
