

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
RESOLUTION NO. 2013-131**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Hardin County Fiscal Court that the County does, upon the completion of the Bullion Boulevard Connector and standard maintenance of existing routes (including resurfacing the deleted sections of the state routes), agrees to accept the maintenance responsibility from the edge of pavement of the Bullion Boulevard Connector to the right of way line, and agrees to accept the following roadway sections and their adjacent right of way into the County Road System and have all rights, responsibility, title, and ownership for the operation and maintenance of this facility:

- 1) ***KY 1500 Roadbed** from Lt. Station 225+25.00 northerly to KY 1500 Approach Road, a total distance of approximately 0.026 miles (Sheet R8);*
- 2) ***Red Hill Road Approach** from Bullion Boulevard Connector Rt. Station 233+90.00 eastwardly, a total distance of approximately 0.043 miles (Sheet R8);*
- 3) ***Oakwood Circle Approach** from Bullion Boulevard Connector at Rt. Station 300+00.00 southeasterly, a total distance of approximately .130 miles (Sheet R16,R18);*
- 4) ***Safari Trail Approach** from Bullion Boulevard Connector Lt. Station 300.00 westerly, a total distance of approximately 0.085 miles (Sheet R18);*
- 5) ***Safari Trail Tie In** from Approach to Safari Trail at Lt. Station 48+00.00 northerly to existing Safari Trail, a total distance of approximately 0.066 miles (Sheet R18);*
- 6) ***Permanent Drainage Easement** along Safari Trail Tie In, approximately 14,067 square feet (Sheet R18);*
- 7) ***Safari Trail Cul de Sac** from Bullion Boulevard Connector Lt. Station 320+15.99 northeasterly, a total distance of approximately 0.031 miles (Sheet R22);*
- 8) ***Safari Trail Approach** from Bullion Boulevard Connector Rt. Station 322+00.00 easterly, a total distance of approximately 0.071 miles (Sheet R22); and*
- 9) ***Cedar Oak Drive Approach** from Bullion Boulevard Connector Lt. Station 322+00.00 northwesterly, a total distance of approximately 0.063 miles (Sheet R22);*

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Hardin County Fiscal Court that the Judge/Executive of Hardin County is hereby authorized and directed to sign said resolution, as set forth, on behalf of the Hardin County Fiscal Court and the County Clerk of Hardin County is hereby authorized and directed to certify thereto.






