

Re: Health Services Agreement

Dear Mr. Allen:

I hope this letter finds you well. SHP's Health Services Agreement with Hardin County is coming up for renewal in July, and we look forward to another year of providing services. We are offering to continue the medical program with a one and one half (1.5%) base fee and per diem rate increase beginning on July 1, 2014.

The renewal pricing terms based on a 1.5% increase are noted below for your records:

Contract period:	July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015
Base annualized fee:	\$801,927.84
Base monthly fee:	\$66,827.32
Per diem greater than 550:	\$1.31
Annual outside cost pool limits:	\$100,000.00 (first tier) (80% Cost Pool Refund) \$120,000.00 (second tier)

Rather than formally extending our Agreement for another year by contract Amendment, we are requesting a signature below on behalf of the County to acknowledge the new base price and per diem rate for the 2014-2015 period. Please have this letter signed on behalf of the County and return a copy to my attention by fax (423-305-6972) or email (lacey.lafuze@southernhealthpartners.com). We will make the billing adjustment beginning with SHP's invoice for July 2014 services, and all provisions of the contract will remain in full force and effect through the renewal period unless amended or modified in writing by the parties.
