RESOLUTION NO. 2014-117**


**BE IT RESOLVED**, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following change within the EMS Department:

7. The hiring of Summer Cook, part time Paramedic, Grade 8, Step EL, at \$12.47 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$200, and without scheduled overtime, effective 10 August 2014.
8. The change of status of Joshua Tomes, from full time EMT, 40 hour work week, Grade 8, Step 1, to full time EMT, 56 hour work week, Grade 4, Step 1, at \$10.99 per hour, with no change in uniform allowance, and with scheduled overtime, effective 10 August 2014.
