BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:

1. The resignation of Latesa Barnes, EMS Clerk, effective 25 February 2015.
2. The change of status of Crystal Bland, from full time EMT, 40 hour work week, Grade 8, Step EOI, to full time EMT, 40 hour work week, Grade 8, Step 6, at \$14.67 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$400, and without scheduled overtime, effective retroactive 30 November 2014.


