

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
RESOLUTION NO. 2015-064**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:

1. The movement of Daniel Killian, from Grade 8, Step EL, to Grade 8 Step EOI, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$13.09 per hour with uniform allowance of \$400 per fiscal year, and without scheduled overtime, retroactive effective 22 February 2015.
2. The hiring of William B. Gerard, part time Paramedic, Grade 8, Step EL, at \$12.47 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, and without scheduled overtime, effective 15 April 2015.
3. The resignation of Jonathon Ennis, Paramedic, effective 15 April 2015.
