


**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2015-072**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to accept the bid by Brandenburg Telecom, LLC,. to provide telephone and internet service at the Hardin County Government Center, 150 N. Provident Way, Elizabethtown, Kentucky in the amount of \$5,831.00 for equipment (session border controller) and \$2,303.45 monthly service cost.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to authorize the Judge/Executive and the County Attorney to execute the contract for the service.

PRI Contract

Brandenburg Telecom, LLC ("Brandenburg") agrees to provide two PRI's and 30 SIP trunks to the new Hardin County Government Building (Hardin County) on Ring Rd. in Elizabethtown. The 30 SIP trunks include all call features and 30,000 domestic long distance minutes. The monthly price for the 30 SIP trunks and the two PRI's is \$2,198.50 a month, not including taxes and surcharges. As part of this contract, Brandenburg will also install approximately 230 feet of cabling from the existing dmark in Room 55 to the extended dmark in Room 31.

Brandenburg will also provide a 50 meg down and 5 meg up internet connection for Hardin County for \$99.95 with a static IP address for \$5 a month. Hardin County can upgrade the internet connection at any time without any contract penalties. Brandenburg could also provide a 100 meg down and 20 meg up internet connection for \$399.95 a month.

Brandenburg will have these services live to the building prior to May 18, 2015 and Brandenburg will work with the County IT staff on the transfer of the existing phone numbers to make sure the current telephone numbers stay active during the transition to the new building. Hardin County will need to notify Brandenburg five days in advance of each office moving to the new building in order to make this transition seamless.

Brandenburg will provide Hardin County with 24/7 customer support for these services and will have someone working on any outage within two hours of being contacted by Hardin County.

All three services (PRI's, SIP trunks, and internet service) will be under a three year contract. In exchange for this three year commitment, Brandenburg will not charge any installation fees. The only non-recurring charge will be for a session border control and it will be \$5,831.00. If Hardin County disconnects these services prior to the three year contract ending, Hardin County will be responsible for all monies owed on this three year contract.
