


**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to authorize the County Judge/Executive to sign all documents concerning this grant, so as to expedite the grant process.

What Equipment are you requesting for your department? The McGrath MAC enhanced direct laryngoscope. A multipurpose device that can be used for both direct and video laryngoscopy during both difficult airway management and routine laryngoscopy. Several case studies have reported improved laryngeal views and greater first-attempt success rates.		Briefly explain how the equipment will benefit your community and your department. <small>First-attempt success significantly decreases morbidity and mortality in patients that require endotracheal intubation. Children less than 18 years of age make up 25.1% and 65 and older make up 12.3% of Hardin County's population (2014 census) both being notorious for difficult airway management, especially trauma. Video will allow paramedics to visualize the airways anatomy in real time onscreen. Hardin County EMS trains and assists other counties where this will improve patient outcomes.</small>

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Have you successfully reached out to the city for funds to purchase the equipment? <small>Yes, the budget didn't allow for the purchase with this Fiscal Year. Major equipment for improved patient outcomes was the Lucas 2 device and optimistically with the McGrath video laryngoscope and Lucas 2 device, patient morbidity and mortality will decrease especially with the under 18 trauma patient.</small>	Was there a particular instance where a life would have been positively impacted if you would have had the equipment available? <small>Yes, On June 22, 2014 17 year old was struck by a drunk driver. She was a difficult intubation/airway. She needed video laryngoscopy to visualize her anatomy due to the trauma she endured during the vehicle crash. A week later, her brother at 20 years old crashed his ATV sustaining a traumatic brain injury. He too, could have benefited from video laryngoscopy due to the darkness, terrain and head trauma all of which are challenges for Paramedics to maintain these difficult airways. Both passed away and were organ donors.</small>
What positive effects will the equipment specifically have? Please use statistics when possible. <small>Hardin County EMS used the McGrath Video on a trial bases during the month of July 2015. The overall success rate of endotracheal intubations went up 17% from June 2015, 9% more success than August 2015 and 12% more than September of 2015. When an airway is critical this device offers a more detailed view, better magnification and illumination of the airway. Using video also enhances teamwork during intubation, thus offering opportunities for education and clinical assistance of the difficult or traumatic airway.</small>
