Hardin County EMS and Hardin County E-911 are collaborating together with Sungard/OSSI(Public Sector Dispatch) and ESO Solutions, Inc. (Patient care Reporting/Billing System) to improve the accuracy of computer aided dispatch data. Dispatchers can instantly share real-time data and knowledge of changing events with Emergency Responders, improving efficiency, communication and most of all...safety to our Emergency Responders! Presently, crews are required to manually enter patient information into the Patient Care Report (PCR), but this interface will automatically populate the PCR, thus allowing EMS responding personnel more time to spend caring for patient's and not paperwork. As you will see, that is only the beginning and foundation of the innovative software!

This CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) software will most definitely streamline our communications between multiple agencies, encouraging collaboration and reducing operational costs. The CAD interface between the agencies will provide accurate information directly to a laptop located inside the ambulance and/or emergency vehicle. This allows our Paramedics/EMT's to access critical information in real-time. In addition, Hardin County E-911 currently uses "Emergency Medical Dispatch Software" to provide pre-hospital instructions and medical advice to callers as needed. This transcript is also sent to the responding units, giving even further life-saving information to responding personnel. Likewise, the CAD interface will provide multi-jurisdictional support for stronger information sharing during times of mass-casualties. It will also integrate mapping for responding crews for a visual reference as well as the ability to get Google Maps and data from neighboring jurisdictions when called upon for mutual aid.

The CAD interface will simply monitor the secure E-911 server, looking for EMS calls. When an EMS call is received, the interface will pull the required information and send it to the EMS crew instantly! Any transactions are done via a secure server and protects patient information both medical and financial information. Once launched, the CAD interface continues to work indefinitely, requiring only occasional software upgrades.
