

## PART B

### SECTION A: PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. This is an expansion of a project (HHW) that we have participated in several previous years. We would like to include our annual E-Scrap event also. Typically we only collect HHW items during a 1 day event. However, the county generally pays 100% for a separate E-scrap event. In the past we have trained our citizens to prepare for a Spring and Fall event to help dispose of all the items properly. Both of these events for the previous year were huge success. We almost doubled the volume on both events as compared to the past. We will contract the services of a qualified environmental firm to collect and properly dispose of all this material. Participation in the both events continues to increase from year to year as more become aware of these annual events. As participation increases, so does the cost to sponsor these events. Even with a state grant for HHW last year of \$22,936.85, the overall cost of that event was about \$31,000. The overall cost for the E-Scrap was an additional \$8,000.00. I am expecting participation and cost to be even greater for this year.
2. We will have one (2) drop-off sites located in the Industrial Park in the City of Elizabethtown (1 for HHW and 1 for E-scrap). These are central locations and have worked well in the past. This site will serve Elizabethtown, Radcliff, West Point, Vine Grove, Upton, Sonora and other smaller unincorporated areas of the county.

These both will be a one day event each and we anticipate a large response.

- Both sites we have used in the past have a large paved area, properly marked with safety cones and volunteers to assist in unloading the vehicles. We will have a qualified environmental firm on site, properly staffed, to handle any materials delivered to us. The hours will be from 8:00 AM until 2:00 PM, and extended if necessary.

## **SECTION B: PROJECT ADVERTISING AND EDUCATION**

- We will promote via a local radio station and local newspapers. We will have printed brochures for distribution in local industries, schools and government buildings. Prior to the event (1-2 weeks), we will place a large banner at the collection point giving the date, time and a brief list of items accepted. This will also be listed on our web-site.
- Most of the promotions will be done by the local government along with businesses located in the Industrial Park. The league of Women Voters and the Woman's club of Elizabethtown have assisted us in the past.
