**BE IT RESOLVED**, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:


1. The resignation of Patrick Tiernan, Paramedic, effective 16 April 2016.


**Subject:** Letter of Resignation
