- V. RECOMMEND TO HAVE JUDGE BERRY SEND A LETTER TO THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT REQUESTING THAT THE RIGHT-OF-WAY ALONG HWY 220 UP TO DECKARD SCHOOL ROAD BE SPRAYED AFTER IT IS MOWED TO PREVENT GRASS AND WEEDS FROM BLOCKING VIEW OF TRAFFIC.

ROAD COMMITTEE MINUTES

JUNE 25, 2003

Members Present: Bill Hay, Chairman, Phillip Crady, Tommy Jagers, Danny Allen, Road Supervisor and Becky Thomas, Road Department Office Manager.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m. at the Hardin County Road Department.

Concern Citizens: There were no concerned citizens present.

The Committee discussed request to install 35 - mph speed limit on Ash Ln and Pebble Brook Ln. After discussion committee agreed to recommend the speed limits.

The Committee agreed to recommend accepting the following streets in Stoneridge Subdivision into the maintenance system:

— COBBLESTONE DR	- .171 —
IVORY CT	- .070
SAPPHIRE CT	- .056
FEATHERSTONE CT	- .062
MARBLE TRACE	- .065
JASMINE CT	- .064
RIMROCK CT	- .056
QUARTZ DR	- .136

The entrance to Stoneridge needs to be repaired by the Developer.

The committee also agreed to accept the following streets in Pointers Ridge Subdivision:

POINTERS CT	- .216
EXTENSION OF OAKBROOK LN	- .041

Committee agreed to recommend installing a 25-mph speed limit on all streets in Stoneridge subdivision and Pointers Ridge Subdivision.

The Committee discussed the request to install rumble strips on Deckard School Road at the intersection of Hwy 220. After discussing the area and the cost of the milled strips the Committee agreed to recommend having Capital Sawing and Drilling to install the strips. The committee agreed also to have Judge Berry write a letter to the State Highway Department requesting that the right-of-way along Hwy 220 to Deckard School Road be sprayed after it is mowed to prevent grass and weeds from blocking view of traffic.

Magistrate Jagers asked that hole at the storm drain at 370 Wildwood Dr is fixed and to put some Class II rock be put in ditch. He also asked the road supervisor to look at a tile problem at 47 Kings Way. Magistrate Jagers asked for a cost estimate for taxation on Morris Ln in Upton.

Magistrate Crady asked that all sections of Wooldridge Ferry Road be posted with 35-mph speed limits. He also said that one side of the entrance of Adams Ln is fixed where

the school bus has messed it up. Magistrate Crady requested that next year when the road department starts mowing that the mowers begin in his district and to rotate areas when we begin mowing after that. Magistrate Hay will ask the Sanitation committee if a landfill employee could mow the area from Springfield Road to Stovall Road only for the first mowing.

Danny Allen, road supervisor told the committee that all road on the state-paving list has been completed. He told the committee he would pave 2 roads in each district so that all areas would have roads paved. He will try to complete the list turned in by each magistrate.

Danny also told the committee that he had asked the County Attorney about the road department doing work in the cities of West Point, Vine Grove, Radcliff, the County Attorney said that there should be a local agreement between Hardin County Fiscal Court and the Cities so that there would be no problems concerning liability.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 am.
