The amount of the contract is \$48,000.00 annually to be paid monthly. Bluegrass Recycling Service, Inc. will pick up dead stock within Hardin County Monday through Friday. The animals shall include but not be limited



to cattle, horses, hogs, ostrich, llamas, goats, and sheep. They will also pickup up deer of small diffinats, if located at an agreed upon location. All collected dead stock will be disposed of through rendering at the following location:

- Reports are made quarterly to Fiscal Court, including details about the service and contact information. These reports are aired on local television 6 times with widespread viewing throughout the county.
