Dear Judge Executive Berry and Hardin County Fiscal Court Magistrates:

We are ARHHC, Inc. (Association for Retarded and Handicapped of Hardin County, Inc.) a non-profit organization serving the special needs of individuals within our community. We have been in operation since 1955, we operate a Day Habilitation program know; as Project L.E.A.R.N., for adults 21 years and older with special needs. Project L.E.A.R.N. is open five days a week, year round, our goal is to help our clients maintain and acquire skills in a safe nurturing environment. We also sponsor the Summer Recreation and Retention Program that operates four weeks in the summer for special needs children still in school.

We are currently leasing a building from the county which is located on 225 College St. here in Elizabethtown. We have been leasing this building for more than forty years. Our lease agreement states that the up keep and maintenance of the building is our responsibility and this has been accomplished without any major problems over the years, we have made many improvements to the building. We are currently in need of assistance with replacing the roof of the rear section of the building.

The rear section of the building's roof is currently leaking in the center, upon inspection, roof was found to be in very poor condition. The replacement is projected to cost around \$20,000. This leak effects the large recreation area in the back section of the building which is utilized by both programs sponsored by ARHHC, Inc. However water leaking onto the floor during the four weeks the summer program meets is most critical due to the fact that this is the only area occupied by them.

Your assistance in replacing the roof or even if you could split the cost would be greatly appreciated. The best quote we received is from a company in Munfordville, KY; RD (Randy Detweiler) Commercial Roofing came in at \$1600.00
