


**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2016-127**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:


1. The change of status of Arnold Blakely, from full time Paramedic, 56-hour work week, Grade 8, Step EL, to part time Paramedic Grade 8, Step EL, at \$12.72 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$200, and without scheduled overtime, effective 7 August 2016.
2. The resignation of Charles Eatmon, Paramedic, effective 16 August 2016.
3. The promotion of Timothy Carr, from full time Paramedic, 56-hour work week, Grade 8, Step 8, to Paramedic Asst. Supervisor, 56-hour work week, Grade 9, Step 8, at \$16.20 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$400, and with scheduled overtime, effective 4 August 2016.
4. The promotion of Summer Cook, from full time Paramedic, 56-hour work week, Grade 8, Step 2, to Paramedic Asst. Supervisor, 56-hour work week, Grade 9, Step 2, at \$14.60 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$400, and with scheduled overtime, effective 4 August 2016.
5. The resignation of Daniel Killian, EMT, effective 30 August 2016
6. The resignation of Gary Mayes, Paramedic, effective 14 September 2016
7. The change of status of John Conover, from full time Paramedic, 56-hour work week, Grade 8, Step EL, to part time Paramedic Grade 8, Step EL, at \$12.72 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$200, and without scheduled overtime, effective 4 September 2016.
8. The demotion of Mike Benningfield, from Paramedic-Assistant Shift Supervisor, 56-hour work week, Grade 9, Step 3, to full time Paramedic, 56-hour work week, Grade 8, Step 3, at \$14.18 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$400, and with scheduled overtime, effective 4 September 2016.




