
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to authorize the Judge/Executive and the County Attorney to execute the contract.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
WITH
HARDIN COUNTY SHERIFF
FOR
HARDIN COUNTY DRUG COURT**

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into on this 13 day of Sept. 2016, by and between Hardin County Fiscal Court, 150 North Provident Way, Elizabethtown, Kentucky 42701(Fiscal Court) and the Hardin County Sheriff (Sheriff) and shall govern Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Fiscal Court in the exercise of its lawful duties has made monies available to assist the operation Hardin County Drug Court;

WHEREAS, the local Hardin County Drug Court Program has determined the best use of these local county- provided funds;

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Sheriff has agreed to provide staff dedicated to serve as a Law Enforcement Liaison to Hardin County Drug Court;

WHEREAS, Hardin County continues to receive a benefit by partnering to provide treatment for those addicted to drugs, including possible reduction in incarceration costs for inmates at the Hardin County Detention Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

SCOPE of SERVICES:

1. Hardin County Fiscal Court has budgeted \$50,000 for the operation of Hardin County Drug Court for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 retroactive to July 1, 2016;
2. Of that amount budgeted to Hardin County Drug Court, **\$22,114.56 will be paid directly to the Hardin County Sheriff** for its provision of personnel for the position of *Hardin County Drug Court Law Enforcement Liaison* to assist the Hardin County Drug Court program;
3. The Hardin County Treasurer will disburse the full amount to the Hardin County Sheriff for this purpose upon presentation of appropriate invoice.
4. The *Law Enforcement Liaison* funded by this MOA will be an employee of the Hardin County Sheriff for any and all purposes including but not limited to unemployment benefits, workman's compensation, retirement and/or insurance benefits, or liability.

5. Any costs incurred above and beyond the amount of this agreement for the provision of a Drug Court Law Enforcement Liaison are the sole responsibility of the Hardin County Sheriff.

PAYMENT:

The total expenses reimbursed under this Agreement shall not exceed **\$22,114.56** for the contract period: July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017.

By signing this Agreement, all parties agree to all of the conditions as stated above:


