
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to authorize the Judge/Executive and the County Attorney to execute the contract.

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into on this 23rd day of Sept. 2016, by and between Hardin County Fiscal Court, 150 North Provident Way, Elizabethtown, Kentucky 42701 (Fiscal Court) and the Administrative Office of the Courts, 1001 Vandalay Drive, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601 (AOC) and shall govern Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Fiscal Court in the exercise of its lawful duties has made monies available to assist the operation of Hardin County Drug Court;

WHEREAS, the local Hardin County Drug Court Program has determined the best use of these local county- provided funds;

WHEREAS, AOC is actively involved in the administration and operation of Kentucky Drug Courts statewide, and has staff and resources necessary to continue this function;

WHEREAS, Hardin County continues to receive a benefit by partnering to provide treatment for those addicted to drugs, including possible reduction in incarceration costs for inmates at the Hardin County Detention Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

SCOPE of SERVICES:

1. The AOC through its various agencies and departments accepts responsibility for administration and operation of the Hardin County Drug Court project, so as to allow for the consistent and complete management of the project.
2. Hardin County Fiscal Court has budgeted \$50,000 for the operation of Hardin County Drug Court for Fiscal Year 2016-2017, retroactive to July 1, 2016.
3. Of that amount budgeted to Hardin County Drug Court, \$13,600 will be in the form of reimbursement of **personnel expenses only** for the position of *administrative assistant* to the Hardin County Drug Court program for a total amount not to exceed **\$13,600.00** for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2017.
4. The Hardin County Treasurer will reimburse AOC upon receipt of supporting documentation and/or proof of payment rendered for personnel expenses for an administrative assistant to the Hardin County Drug Court on a monthly basis.

4. The administrative assistant funded under this MOA will not be an employee of Hardin County government for any purpose, including but not limited to unemployment benefits, workman's compensation, retirement and/or insurance benefits or liability.

5. Any costs incurred above and beyond the amount of this agreement are the sole responsibility of AOC.

CANCELLATION:

Either party may cancel this Agreement at any time for cause and may cancel without cause on a 30-day written notice. If either party cancels under either provision, the Fiscal Court is only responsible for payment of services completed before the date of cancellation.

PAYMENT:

1. The total expenses reimbursed under this Agreement shall not exceed \$13,600 for the contract period July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017.


2. AOC will provide supporting documentation and proof of payments under this agreement to the Fiscal Court for reimbursement on a monthly basis. The Hardin County Drug Court Director or designee will monitor and approve all invoices before reimbursement is requested.




