

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2017-006**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following change within the EMS Department:

1. The resignation of Chad G. Ubbelohde, part-time EMT, effective 12 January 2017.
2. The resignation of Christopher E. Becker, part-time Paramedic, effective 10 January 2017.
3. The promotion of Brittany L. Cureton, from full-time Paramedic, 56-hour work week, Grade 8, Step 6, at \$14.97 per hour, to Paramedic Assistant Shift Supervisor, 56-hour work week, Grade 9, Step 6, at \$15.72 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$400 per fiscal year, and with scheduled overtime, effective 22 January 2017.
4. The change of status of Robert R. Gnagie, part-time Paramedic, Grade 8, Step Entry Level, at \$12.72 per hour, to full-time 56 hour Paramedic, Grade 8, Step Entry Level, at \$12.72 per hour, with uniform allowance of \$400 per fiscal year, and with scheduled overtime, effective 5 February 2017.
