### WORK SESSION NOVEMBER 4, 2003

Judge/Executive Berry called to order the Working Session of the Hardin County Fiscal Court.

Squire Easter gave the opening prayer.

Squire Hay led the court in the pledge to the flag.

Mr. Hay commented on some of the recommendations from the Road Committee meeting that will be presented on next week.

Mr. Wiseman, Sanitation Committee, reported on doing cleanup on Springfield Road and that the exemptions for mandatory garbage collection will be looked at again.

There will be a Public Hearing on closing Jagers Road on November 25, 2003.

There will be a Veteran's Day Parade in Vine Grove on Saturday, November 8<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Brandenburg reported there will be a Finance Committee Meeting on November 10, 2003 at 8:00 a. m. at the library.

Ken Howard, County Attorney, gave an update on the lawsuits that have been filed on delinquent payments on trash collection. Most of these have been resolved either by payment or exemptions. Only one case has gone to court.
