Enclosed is your application for a 2016 residential trash exemption. Please read the entire notice before filling out the application and **include proof of income**.

You will need to contact the County's billing service and pay all past due amounts before submitting your application. **Any applicant with a past due amount owed will be DENIED.**

The deadline for returning the application to our office is December 7, 2015. **Any applications received after December 7, 2015 or any applications that do not include proof of income will be DENIED and you will not be eligible to reapply for the 2016 calendar year.**

NOTICE

Hardin County Fiscal Court's Solid Waste Ordinance 163, Series 2001 and subsequent Amendment No.1 address possible exemptions from paying the pickup fees for residential waste. A copy of the section pertaining to this subject is show below:

The Hardin County Fiscal Court may exempt from paying a fee for the collection of solid waste as provided by this ordinance a residential household which earns less the Federal poverty level guidelines as determined from time to time by the United States Department of Health and Human Services or other financial hardship circumstances.

The Director shall promulgate an appropriate form supported by verifiable information which shall be submitted by each head of household requesting such exemption. The Director shall approve or deny each application.

The decision of the Director may be appealed to the Hardin County Solid Waste Appeal Board whose decision shall be final.

An approved application shall be valid for a maximum period of one (1) year unless otherwise modified or revoked by the Director based on a change of circumstances of the applicant.

Any approved applicant who has an increase in income shall report same to the Director within twenty (20) days of receipt of same.

Any applicant who has a past due bill from the County's waste billing service company will have their application "denied". When bill is paid in full the applicant may reapply.
