

**HARDIN COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE NO. 267A, SERIES 2009**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REAPPORTIONMENT AND  
REDISTRICTING OF THE MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS OF HARDIN COUNTY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HARDIN COUNTY,  
KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1**

As provided in KRS 67.045 and pursuant to the November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008 general election to return to a county fiscal court comprised of eight (8) Justice of the Peace (magistrates) and the 2000 decennial census of the United States; the reapportionment and redistricting of the eight magisterial districts of Hardin County as recommended by the Reapportionment Commission duly appointed by resolution of Hardin County Fiscal Court on February 10, 2009, amended by resolution on February 24<sup>th</sup>, and its commissioners sworn on March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2009 in their written report dated April 17, 2009 submitted to and received by Hardin County Fiscal Court on April 23, 2009 is hereby amended by Hardin County Fiscal Court as set out below. Each magisterial district of Hardin County shall have the following voting precincts, in their entirety, in each district, and shall constitute the reapportioned magisterial districts in conformity with KRS 67.045 and the 2000 decennial census of the United States:

**SECTION II**

Per the requirements of KRS 67.050 (4), the change in the composition of the fiscal court and the magisterial districts represented by Justices of the Peace (magistrates) shall become effective upon the assumption of office of the Justices of the Peace elected at the next regular election for that office.

**SECTION III**

If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

**SECTION IV**


