

HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT

**WORKING SESSION
JUNE 8, 2010**

There being present Commissioner King, Commissioner Brandenburg, Commissioner Hay and Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry presiding.

Assistant County Judge, Jim Roberts, proposed three changes to the Administrative Code. Judge Berry pointed out the Code was reviewed in March and voting on the code was postponed until June 8.

Mr. Roberts brought to the courts attention that Section II, Part A was incorrect. It should read KRS 68.240 instead of KRS 68.420.

He also recommended that Section II Part B be changed to first meeting in June instead of June 10.

The consensus was to leave the date the way it is.

Mr. Roberts pointed out in Section II Part B assigning committees to be changed by the amendment he presented to the court.

Commissioner Brandenburg wanted Chapters 3, 5 and 10 out of the Administrative Code.

Mr. Roberts felt that Chapter 3 would be a great benefit to incoming magistrates.

Judge Berry added that Section 1 A and B are part of the statutes. Section II A is from a statute. Section II B is the only part added by the Administrative Code.

The consensus was to take 2 B out of Chapter 3 with Judge Berry objecting.

The court would have to adopt a resolution as to the Powers and Duties of Fiscal Court.

Chapter 5 was discussed as not being relevant to the Administrative Code. As well as Chapter 10.

Commissioner Brandenburg had a concern with Chapter 4 Section V Part D as to the Judge/Executive making an appointment without Fiscal Court ratification.

It was determined to leave as is.

Commissioner King on Section II: Commissioner King asked if the Deputy Judge could preside at Fiscal Court meetings. The Deputy Judge cannot preside over Fiscal Court meetings.

On Page 11, Section IV B, Commissioner King wanted a clarification as to the Judge/Executive appointing positions for an undetermined period of time. It was determined that the Judge could appoint, but the Fiscal Court had to approve the payment to the employee.

Judge Berry summarized by stating that the Administrative Code would be postponed until June 22. The Code would be amended by removing Section II of Chapter 3, and removing Chapter 5 and 10. The deleted portions would be dealt with by Resolution.

Court was adjourned, without objection, Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry presiding.
