

HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING SEPTEMBER 07, 2010

Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry called the Hardin County Fiscal Court Meeting to order and requested a roll call vote. Voting: Judge Berry yes, King yes, Brandenburg yes, Hay yes.

The invocation was given by Commissioner Hay.

Commissioner Brandenburg led the court in the pledge of allegiance.

Judge Berry turned the meeting over to First Assistant County Attorney, Jenny Pitts Oldham, to conduct a Public Hearing for the County Property Tax Rates. Judge Berry presented the 2010 County Tax Rates recommendations.

Ms. Pitts Oldham requested public comment. Commissioner Brandenburg asked that slide 16 be shown a second time. He indicated that this clearly reflected the tax rates each year. Commissioner Hay commented that this court and previous courts had worked to keep tax rates low and he was proud of this. Judge Berry pointed out that 5 of the last 8 years were below the 4% growth rates. The cost of living in those eight years increased 21%. Hearing no other comments Ms. Pitts Oldham closed the hearing.

Judge Berry moved King seconded to approve Resolution No. 2010-095 setting the 2010 County Tax Rates. Voting: King yes, Brandenburg yes, Hay yes, Judge Berry yes.

Judge Berry moved and King seconded to approve the 2011 Motor Vehicle and Watercraft Property Tax Rate at 11.5 cents per \$100.00 of assessed value. Voting: Brandenburg yes, Hay yes, Judge Berry yes, King yes.

Judge Berry asked the minutes reflect that the Hardin County Conservation District for FY 2009/2010 annual report had been received.

King moved and Hay seconded to approve the Kentucky Agricultural Development Board grant for deceased farm animal disposal assistance. Voting: Hay yes, Judge Berry yes, King yes, Brandenburg yes.

Hay moved and Brandenburg seconded to approve Resolution No. 2010-096 relating to Rural Secondary Program agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. Voting: Judge Berry yes, King yes, Brandenburg yes, Hay yes.

Brandenburg moved and Hay seconded to approve Resolution No. 2010-097 relating to the Community Development Block Grant Application for 2008 Disaster Recovery Funds. Voting: King yes, Brandenburg yes, Hay yes, Judge Berry yes.

Commissioner Hay announced that this Saturday, September 11th, will be Howe Valley Days.

Commissioner Brandenburg announced that a recycling truck had been placed at the Farmer's Market and another will soon be placed in Sonora.

Court was adjourned, without objection, Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry presiding.
