WORKING SESSION

MAY 03, 2011

Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry called the Working Session of the Hardin County Fiscal Court to order and requested a roll call vote. Voting: Thompson yes, Morgan yes, King yes, Judge Berry yes, Easter yes, Goodman yes, Williams yes, Clem yes, Wiseman yes.

The invocation was given by Squire Morgan.

Squire Wiseman led the court in the pledge of allegiance.

Judge Berry swore in Carolyn Ritchie for her new four year term as County Treasurer.

Squire Goodman asked about the step increases recommended for the county employees. He also asked about the \$5,000.00 for office equipment.

Squire Morgan asked about Economic Development Appropriations.

Squire Morgan indicated that the county should not use tax payers' money to fund the community support account that totals \$22,000.00.

Squire Goodman asked why some communities received money in community support and others did not.

Squire Williams indicated an interest for the court to fund the Elizabethtown Heritage Council.

Judge Berry requested that the Budget be approved for Community Support and during the course of the year recommendations can be made in regard to changes.

Squire Easter asked about the costs incurred at the hospital for salt and snow removal, etc. during the course of the year.

Discussion followed by what would the county cut out of the budget if the dividend of \$350,000.00 was not taken from the hospital?

Judge Berry proposed that the three commissioners for magisterial reapportionment be selected the last meeting in May.

Court was adjourned, without objection, Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry presiding.
