REGULAR MEETING DECEMBER 21, 2012

Clem moved and Wiseman seconded to approve the Consent Agenda to include approving Claims Batch No. 06-7021, approving Resolution No. 2012-183 relating to financial transfers, approve Resolution No. 2012-186 revising the Human Resources Specialist/Safety Coordinator's job description, approve Resolution No. 2012-187 revising the Information Technology Specialist's job description, approve Detention Center's November 2012 report, approve Resource and Community Support Committee's 12/18/12 minutes, approve Solid Waste Committee's 12/19/12 minutes, approve Emergency Services Committee's 12/20/12 minutes, and approve Fiscal Court Minutes dated 12/11/12.
