Your County Breaks Ground for New Government Center

Your County Government broke ground on Friday, December 20 for our new government center. The new building will be located next to our County Emergency Services Center near the intersection of Rineyville and Ring Roads, adjacent to the new Patriot Parkway.

We are excited to begin this long-awaited project. We anticipate we will move into the new building within 12 to 15 months. The 60,000 sq. ft. building will consolidate the following county offices in one single, convenient location.

- County Sheriff
- PVA
- Planning & Development
- Engineering
- Finance
- Solid Waste
- Code Enforcement
- E-911 Center



The total cost for the construction is \$13.1M. We will finance \$11M and schedule our first debt service payment in FY 2015/16 when our current annual debt service decreases as shown on the graph above.

The savings gained from the retirement of some current debt obligations in FY 2015/16 will free up the funds necessary to make payments on the new building.

As you can see by the graph, our annual debt service payments will remain the same or below the level we currently pay.
