





Our County's Pearl Hollow Landfill, located at 1620 Audubon Trace, annually offers county residents four Saturdays to dispose of their unwanted items at no charge.

8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

All loads must be secured and covered. Refrigerators and air conditioners must have the freon gas removed and a proper stamp applied. No tires, batteries, anti-freeze, motor oil, paint, or any free-flowing liquids will be accepted at this location.



Directions: From Interstate 65, take Exit 93 to Blue Grass Parkway. Travel East on Blue Grass Parkway 8 miles to Exit 8. Turn right and immediately turn right again onto Audubon Trace Road.
