## Household Hazardous Waste Collection September 8 from 8 am to 2 pm

**Recycling is very important.** There are plenty of reasons why recycling is important. The world population is growing, not shrinking, and currently each human being adds significant waste to the planet over a lifetime. In New York alone, people produce enough trash in one day to fill the Empire State building. The frustrating thing is, in most developed countries it's not too difficult to make a difference. **We are running out of space for waste.** Landfill sites across our country are filling up fast. Making products from raw materials costs much more than if they were made from recycled products. Recycling reduces the need for raw materials; it also uses less energy, therefore preserving natural resources for the future.

### Interesting Facts:

- ◇ 1 recycled tin can = enough energy to power a television for 3 hours
- ◇ 1 recycled glass bottle = enough energy to power a computer for 25 minutes
- ◇ 1 recycled plastic bottle = enough energy to power a 60-watt light bulb for 3 hours
- ◇ 70% less energy is required to recycle paper compared with making it from raw materials
