Road Funding

The Commonwealth of Kentucky imposes a “Motor Fuels Tax” on gasoline, liquefied petroleum, and special fuels. The tax is levied on the average wholesale price per gallon. The tax becomes a liability of the dealer when the gasoline is received or enters the dealer’s storage facility. Unlike most taxes collected by the Department of Revenue, motor fuels taxes, along with vehicle sales taxes, are deposited in a statewide Road Fund and appropriated by the General Assembly for the construction and maintenance of Kentucky’s roads.

The Road Fund finances State Roads as well as County Roads. (*State Roads are numbered while County Roads are named.*) The Office of Rural Secondary Roads administers three revenue sharing programs funded by motor fuel taxes. These programs include the County and Municipal Road Aid Cooperative programs, and the Rural Secondary Program. Property Taxes do not fund county road maintenance

Road Work Ahead for Summer

This summer, our County Road Department plans to pave George Tabb Road, Hansborough Road, Thompson Road, and Summit Eastview Road utilizing Rural Secondary Funds of approximately \$358,746.



Utilizing \$87,480 from the Municipal Road Aid Cooperative Program, our County Road Department will pave Partridge Way and Pinewood Drive.

In addition to the State Road Funds, we also receive Local Government Economic Assistance funding from the State. We will pave Hayden School Road to the Cecilia Road intersection with these funds.
