- Hardin County is the second county in the state to make this app available
- Introduced in December 2015
- The American Heart Association estimates that effective bystander CPR, provided immediately after sudden cardiac arrest, can double or triple a person's chance of survival.




## Hardin Memorial Hospital, County EMS and E-911 Partner to Provide Live-Saving APP

Hardin Memorial Hospital, Hardin County Emergency Services, and Hardin County 911 are making a new life-saving smartphone application available to county residents.

The **PulsePoint** Foundation is a non-profit organization, building applications that work with local public safety agencies to improve communications with its citizens.

Anyone living or working in Hardin County is encouraged to attain CPR training and download this app. Hardin Memorial Hospital, Hardin County EMS, the American Red Cross, and the Lincoln Trail District Health Department provide CPR training. Approximately 1,400 Hardin County residents have downloaded the app.
