

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 55, SERIES 1989, RELATING  
TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENHANCED 911  
EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE WITHIN  
HARDIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF COUNTY OF HARDIN,  
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION III**

Section Four "911" Advisory Board of Ordinance No. 55, series 1989, shall be modified and amended to read as follows:

**SECTION FOUR. "911" ADVISORY BOARD**

(a) There is hereby established a Hardin County "911"

Advisory Board, which shall be comprised of the following individuals:  
County Representative/ Chairman appointed by the Hardin County  
Judge/Executive; City Representative from each of the participating cities  
appointed by the mayor of each city; Hardin County Sheriff; City of  
Elizabethtown Chief of Police; City of Elizabethtown Fire Chief;  
Representative from Hardin County Fire Chiefs Association appointed by  
President of said association; a Representative from the Hardin County  
Dispatch Service appointed by the Hardin County Jailer; City of Radcliff  
Chief of Police; City of Radcliff Fire Chief; City of Vine Grove Chief of

and Chairman of the Emergency Services Committee, Hardin County Fiscal Court; and a Representative from the Provost Marshall's Office, Fort Knox, Kentucky.

**SECTION IV**

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance, or the application thereof is for any reason found to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not effect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance.

**SECTION V**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.
