

ORDINANCE NO. 68, SERIES 1990

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND AMENEDING
ORDINANCE NO. 55, SERIES 1989, RELATING
TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENHANCED 911
EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE WITHIN
HARDIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF COUNTY OF HARDIN,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

The third "WHEREAS" clause of Ordinance No. 55, Series 1989,
shall be modified and amended to read as follows:

WHEREAS, GTE South is the provider of the local telephone
service and has contracted to provide emergency telephone service
in the city of Elizabethtown, city Sonora, city of Upton, city of
Radcliff, city of Vine Grove and Hardin County, (hereinafter
referred to as "Local Area") and has available enhanced 911
emergency telephone service which will meet the emergency
telephone service needs for the local area; and,

SECTION II

The fifth "WHEREAS" clause of Ordinance No. 55, series 1989,
shall be modified and amended to read as follows:

WHEREAS, the legislative bodies of the city of Elizabethtown,
city of Sonora, city of Upton, city of Radcliff and the city of
Vine Grove, have requested Hardin County to enact an ordinance to
provide emergency answering telephone service for the Local Area;
and

1989, shall be modified and amended to read as follows:

SECTION FOUR. "911" ADVISORY BOARD

- (a) There is hereby established a Hardin County "911" Advisory Board, which shall be comprised of the following individuals: County Representative/Chairman appointed by the Hardin County Judge/Executive; City Representative from each of the participating cities appointed by the mayor of each city; Hardin County Sheriff; City of Elizabethtown Chief of Police; City of Elizabethtown Fire Chief; Representative from Hardin County Fire Chiefs Association appointed by President of said association; a Representative from the Hardin County Dispatch Service appointed by the Hardin County Jailer; City of Radcliff Chief of Police; City of Radcliff Fire Chief; City of Vine Grove Chief of Police; Commander, Kentucky State Police Post #4; Director of the Hardin County Ambulance Service; Project Co-ordinator of Hardin County E-911; and Chairman of the Emergency Services Committee, Hardin County Fiscal Court.
- (b) Said Board shall meet quarterly and the Chairman may call special meetings upon written notice delivered to the members at least seven (7) days prior to any special meeting.

"911" system and make recommendations to the Hardin Fiscal Court for effective implementation of the emergency telephone system.

- (d) Appointed representatives shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority.

SECTION IV

The provisions of ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance, or the application thereof is for any reason found to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not effect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION V

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.

Publicly read and approved by second reading on the 14 day of May, 1990.
