Here are some ways you can promote literacy in your home

- 1. Set aside time each day for reading. Be a reading role model.
- 2. Keep books visible around the house.
- Make regular visits to the library and attend story hours.
- 4. Read the book version of your child's favorite movie.
- 5. Ask our librarian about Kindergarten Readiness resources.
- 6. Connect reading with writing, encourage your child to draw and write.
