The landfill is owned by Hardin County Fiscal Court and operated by Santek Environmental Services of Kentucky.

DIRECTIONS TO PEARL HOLLOW

From Interstate 65 (North or South) take Exit 93 to the Bluegrass Parkway, travel East on the Bluegrass Parkway approximately 8 miles to Exit 8. Turn right and immediately turn right again on to Audubon Trace Road.
