

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-003**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:


1. The resignation of Keith Ables, part-time Paramedic, effective 8 November 2021.
2. The termination of Joshua Darnell, part-time Paramedic, effective 9 November 2021.
3. The movement of Craig Weller from Grade 7, Step EOI to Grade 7, Step 1, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$13.76 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$400 per fiscal year, retroactive 19 December 2021.
4. The movement of Danae Jones from Grade 9, Step EOI to Grade 9, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$15.18 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, retroactive 21 November 2021.
5. The change of status of Robert Gaichin from 56 hour EMT, Grade 5, Step EOI, to part-time EMT, Grade 9, Step EOI, at \$14.88 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, effective 2 January 2022.
6. The change of status of Sabrina Jones from 56 hour EMT, Grade 5, Step 3, to part-time EMT, Grade 9, Step 3, at \$15.79 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, effective 2 January 2022.
7. The change of status of Ryan Berry from 56 hour Paramedic, Grade 9, Step 7, to part-time Paramedic, Grade 13, Step 7, at \$20.57 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, effective 16 January 2022.
8. The change of status of Brittany Rainwater from part-time EMT, Grade 9, Step 2, to 56 hour EMT, Grade 5, Step 2, at \$12.72 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$400 per fiscal year, effective 2 January 2022.
9. The resignation of Bridgette Shelburne, 56 hour EMT, effective 28 December 2021.
