

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT  
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-030**

This Resolution duly made and adopted on this 22nd day of February 2022, by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**WHEREAS**, KRS 64.530 (3) (4) require that the monthly compensation of certain county officers elected by popular vote shall be fixed by the Fiscal Court not later than the first Monday in May in the year in which the officers are elected and the compensation of the officers shall not be changed during the term; and

**WHEREAS**, KRS 64.535 provides that the County Judge/Executive, County Court Clerk, County Jailer who operates a full service jail, which includes the County of Hardin, and the County Sheriff shall receive a salary as indicated in KRS 64.5275; and

**WHEREAS**, the county officers of Hardin County will be elected in 2022 for a term beginning January 1, 2023, and for a period of four (4) years thereafter.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Hardin County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky, as follows:

1. The annual compensation of the Hardin County Attorney for the term beginning January 1, 2023 shall be for each calendar year during the term the equivalent of the statutory 2022 calendar year salary of \$56,145.75 adjusted annually in accordance with the increase or decrease in the consumer price index as determined by the Government Office for Local Development as mandated by KRS 15.765 in order to equate said compensation with the purchasing power of the dollar.
2. The annual compensation of the Hardin County Coroner for the term beginning January 1, 2023 shall be for each calendar year during the term the salary of \$67,296.02 adjusted annually in accordance with the increase or decrease in the consumer price index as determined by the Government Office for Local Development as mandated by KRS 64.527 and as otherwise provided by law in order to equate said compensation with the purchasing power of the dollar.
3. The annual compensation of each Hardin County Magistrate for the term beginning January 1, 2023 shall be for each calendar year during the term the equivalent of the 2022 calendar year Justice of the Peace (Magistrate) salary of \$26,581.12. By unanimous agreement of the members of Fiscal Court, NO adjustment resulting from changes to the consumer price index will be applied to the annual compensation for Justice of the Peace (Magistrate) during the term beginning January 1, 2023.
4. The annual compensation from the Hardin County Treasury and fees of each County Constable for the term beginning January 1, 2023, shall be \$0.00.
5. The annual compensation of the Hardin County Surveyor for the term beginning January 1, 2023 shall be \$0.00


6. The County has approved a Step-in-Grade pay system that is the basis for determining the salary of all employees whose jobs have been assigned to a pay grade. Each year on July 1, the entry level salaries for all pay grades shall increase by the percentage of any annual raise awarded to the County employees on July 1, exclusive of any step-in-grade change. The salary of each step in each pay grade shall be adjusted as set forth in Hardin County Personnel Policies and Procedures Handbook, Chapter 3: Compensation; Section III: Step-in-Grade Increases. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 64.530 (4) the following deputies and/or assistants fiscal year salaries are hereby established:

- A. Deputy Judge/Executive: Grade 28
- B. Deputy Coroner / Administrative Support: Grade 16
- C. Deputy Coroner: Grade 12
