

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-043**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, to approve the following changes within the EMS Department:


1. The resignation of Ryan Clark, part-time EMT-Advanced, effective 23 February 2022.
2. The hiring of Matthew Harper, part-time EMT- Advanced, at Grade 11, Step EOI, at \$17.23 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, effective 10 March 2022.
3. The hiring of Sabrina Eskridge, part-time EMT, at Grade 9, Step EOI, at \$15.62 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$200 per fiscal year, effective 10 March 2022.
4. The hiring of Stetson Gore, 56 hour EMT, at Grade 5, Step EOI, at \$12.84 hourly, with a uniform allowance of \$400 per fiscal year, effective 10 March 2022.
5. The termination of William Johnson, part-time EMT-Advanced, retroactive 09 February 2022.
6. The movement of Jonathan Pudnoff, 56 hour EMT-Advanced, from Grade 8, Step EOI to Grade 8, Step 1, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$15.17 hourly, effective 27 March 2022.
7. The movement of Alli Higdon, 56 hour EMT, from Grade 6, Step EOI to Grade 6, Step 1, upon successful completion of her six-month introductory period, at \$13.76 hourly, effective 10 April 2022.
8. The movement of James Lundy, part-time EMT, from Grade 9, Step EOI to Grade 9, Step 1, upon successful completion of his six-month introductory period, at \$15.93 hourly, effective 10 April 2022.
