MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Amendment 1 and Annual Review – Renewal 1 of 9 of the Intergovernmental Support Agreement #IM-W9124D-20002-IGSA Ground Maintenance between US Army Garrison and Hardin County Government.

1. Reference.

a. IGSA #IM-W9124D-20002-IGSA Ground Maintenance between US Army Garrison and Hardin County Government, 10 March 2021.

b. 10 U.S.C. § 2679 – Installation-Support Services: Intergovernmental Support Agreements.

c. IMCOM IGSA Handbook.

2. Purpose. To renew the Intergovernmental Support Agreement (IGSA or Agreement) providing Ground Maintenance support for the Fort Knox area. Updated financial details and PWS/TECH EXHIBIT data to support changes decided upon prior to renewal period of performance. Two disk will be provided to Hardin County; one for record and one for their contractor to cover the updates required.

3. Renewal. The Parties hereby renew the Refuse IGSA pursuant to the provisions entitled "Terms of Agreement" in the Agreement. Under this renewal, the United States shall only be obligated for an additional one year of performance. This is the first of nine potential renewal option periods contemplated by the Agreement. This renewal will support the Fort Knox Ground Maintenance mission.

4. Fund Condition. This renewal is contingent upon the receipt of funding from Congress. If funds are not received, the Agreements Officer may suspend performance of the renewed period at no additional cost to the United States and reinstate performance once adequate funds are received. The Agreements Officer may also unilaterally terminate the Agreement without further liability to the United States if funds are not received.
