MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Amendment 2 and Annual Review – Renewal 2 of 9 of the Intergovernmental Support Agreement #IM-W9124D-19001-IGSA Refuse between US Army Garrison and Hardin County Government.

1. Reference.

a. IGSA #IM-W9124D-19001-IGSA refuse between US Army Garrison and Hardin County Government, 23 March 2020.

b. 10 U.S.C. § 2679 – Installation-Support Services: Intergovernmental Support Agreements.

c. IMCOM IGSA Handbook.

2. Purpose. To renew the Intergovernmental Support Agreement (IGSA or Agreement) providing refuse support for the Fort Knox area.

3. Renewal. The Parties hereby renew the Refuse IGSA pursuant to the provisions entitled "Terms of Agreement" in the Agreement. Under this renewal, the United States shall only be obligated for an additional one year of performance. This is the second of nine potential renewal option periods contemplated by the Agreement. This renewal will support the Fort Knox refuse mission.

4. Fund Condition. This renewal is contingent upon the receipt of funding from Congress. If funds are not received, the Agreements Officer may suspend performance of the renewed period at no additional cost to the United States and reinstate performance once adequate funds are received. The Agreements Officer may also unilaterally terminate the Agreement without further liability to the United States if funds are not received.
