

**HARDIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-075**

BE IT RESOLVED, upon recommendation of Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry, and pursuant to KRS 67.0802, to declare the real property located at 225 College Street, Elizabethtown, KY 42701 surplus property for disposition retroactive to January 25, 2022. This property is more particularly described as a brick building known as a “workshop” built in 1970 and lying upon .84 acres

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this property was acquired by Hardin County on July 19, 1949, from the United States government by Quitclaim Deed recorded in Deed Book 127, Page 531 and stated at that time to be beneficial to carrying on health center activities by the County. This property has been leased by Project L.E.A.R.N. for nonprofit activities and will continue to be utilized as such with the transfer of ownership to that entity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the method of disposition of the property is sale by sealed bid.

ADOPTED, by Hardin County Fiscal Court in its regular meeting on 12 April 2022.




