
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to authorize Judge/Executive Harry L. Berry to execute all documents concerning the memorandum of agreement.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Larue County Government

And

Hardin County Government

This Agreement is entered this 1st day of July, 2022, by and between Hardin County, Kentucky (County) which is charged with providing for animal control pursuant to KRS 67.083 and Larue County, Kentucky which is charged with providing for animal control pursuant to KRS 67.083. The purpose of this agreement is to provide veterinary services at Hardin County Animal Care and Control for those Felines served through Larue County.

Now, therefore, Hardin County and Larue County, in order to achieve the mutual goals stated above, do hereby agree as follows:

1. Hardin County will provide veterinarian services to Felines served through Larue County. All service requests will flow from Larue County representative to the HCACC director.
2. Services will be provided at 220 Peterson Drive, Elizabethtown, Kentucky. Services rendered to Larue County are secondary to HCACC's normal operations.
3. All felines shall be brought to Hardin County Animal Control by a representative of Larue County government and shall be brought during regular business hours or at a time outside of regular business hours, as agreed on a case-by-case basis. The Larue County government representative shall be responsible for transportation, unloading, and delivery of each feline into the Hardin County Animal Control facility and the timely return and release of each feline.
4. Hardin County will provide spay and neuter services for up to five (5) felines per week on designated days as determined by the HCACC director.

5. Hardin County will provide spay/neuter and basic vaccine services for Larue County at the following agreed upon rate:

<u>HCACC Feline Surgery</u>	<u>Charge</u>
Return to field cat package (Surgery, ear tip, 1 year rabies)	\$40

6. Fees for services not listed above -- if warranted as determined by the HCAC director -- will be determined on a case-by-case basis and are subject to a final determination by the HCACC director.

7. Larue County will submit payment to Hardin County Government within thirty (30 days) of receipt of each invoice.

8. This agreement is for an initial term of two (2) years and will renew for successive one (1) year terms thereafter unless either party provides 120-day written notice to the other party of its desire to terminate this agreement.

9. All subsequent renewals shall increase or decrease in cost in accordance with changes in the Consumer Price Index, all urban consumers, all items, unadjusted as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor statistics, hereinafter referred to as "CPI."
