Cesspool Cleaners	Pesticides

If you happen to miss this event, you can always take the lids off your paint cans and let the paint harden, then it can be placed with your regular trash pickup. Your

local hardware stores that sell paint also sell packs of paint hardener. This will dry up the paint much faster and then it can be placed in your regular trash.
